Personal goals for the school year <i>Tell me what you learned about your personality that has impacted your personal goals.</i>	
Personal Skills Map results <i>What have you discovered about leadership styles, including your own?</i>	
Winning Colors Communication Discovery Form (hard copy) <i>How has Winning Colors helped you and other Cadets work together more effectively?</i>	
Learning style inventory (personal profile) <i>Tell me about your preferred learning style and how you use it to learn more effectively.</i>	
Two samples of course work from JROTC or other academic areas (<u>each sample is worth 2 points</u>) <i>Tell me why you chose each of these samples to share in your portfolio.</i>	
Cadet Challenge results <i>Tell me why you think you got the results you got. What will you do to improve?</i>	
LET 1 Core lesson performance assessment evidence <i>Why did you choose this lesson assessment to share?</i>	
Written reflection on any of the Core Lessons (Service Learning Reflection is a good example that each Cadet should have) <i>How have you been involved in the current Service Learning Project?</i>	
Verbal explanation/summary of curriculum content learned within the year or year-to-date. <i>How has JROTC helped you become a better student? Team player? Leader?</i>
