Standard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 24 credits • State Student Performance Standards • Attainment of State determined score on Florida State Assessments • Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) 2.0
Standard with Merit designation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Same as Standard • One or more Industry Certifications on the State Funding List
Standard with Scholar designation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Same as Standard • One credit in Algebra 2 • One credit in Chemistry or Physics • Two credits in the same World Language • One credit in AP, AICE, IB, or dual enrollment (any subject area) • Pass the grade 11 ELA Florida State Assessment • Pass Algebra 2 EOC • Pass Biology 1 EOC • Pass the U.S. History EOC
International Baccalaureate (see Page 60 for additional information)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • English - 4 credits • Science - 4 credits • Mathematics – 4 credits • Social Studies – 4 credits • Foreign Language – 2 credits • Electives – 8 credits
ACCEL (See Page 61 for additional information)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Same as Standard except 18 credits (although the student may earn more) • One PE is not required • Three electives, not eight • Cumulative weighted GPA of 3.5 • Weighted or un-weighted GPA of 3.0 •
Certificate of Completion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students meet all the requirements of a Standard diploma • Fails to pass the grade 10 FACT 2.0 and/or earn a cumulative GPA of 2.0 • Note: Student may elect to remain in high school as a full or part time student for up to one additional year to receive remedial instruction
Graduate Equivalency Diploma (GED)	Must pass all parts of the High School Equivalency Exam approved by the Department of Education
