

Martin County School District Rules and Regulations For Dances

Students may be required to present a school ID. Failure to do so may result in entry being denied for both student and guest.

- **Special emphasis on any drug/tobacco use or possession will be enforced. All attending must sign drug/tobacco/alcohol no use agreement.**
- **Any student who violates district/school rules may face disciplinary action.**
- **Students who leave during the event will not be readmitted.**
- **No reimbursement or refund will be given when the student is asked to leave the event for not following district and school rules.**
- **No entry after 9:00pm. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- **Established school event dress code will be enforced. Students may be denied entry if they fail to meet event dress code requirements. The final decision as to proper/improper dress will be made by a supervising administrator.**
- **Middle school students and Spectrum students are not permitted to attend high school functions.**

Dress Code

Semi-formal attire is required for the Prom. This includes, but is not limited to:

- **Dresses may be strapless**
- **Dresses may not be shorter than 3 inches from the top of the knee**
- **Dresses may be backless, but only to the waist, not lower**
- **Dresses may not have cut-outs, even if the cut-out is covered with sheer fabric**
- **Dresses may not show midriff**
- **Two piece dresses must overlap**
- **Students may wear a dress shirt and tie**
- **Dress shoes or heels are required**
- **Sneakers, sandals, boat shoes, etc...are not allowed**
- **Jeans, cargo pants, sweat pants, or athletic clothing are not allowed**
