Reminders for Parents and Guardians

Be Aware of The Background

Audio considerations when establishing your child's environment for remote learning:

- Noise from TV or other devices
- Noise from cleaning such as laundry, dishes, vacuuming
- Noise from pets
- Noise from siblings or other people in the household

Visual considerations when establishing your child's environment for remote learning:

- Items on walls such as posters or pictures
- Doors open to other rooms
- Inappropriate items for school in the background
- Underdressed students or members of the family
- Shows on TV or another computer screen



The expectation is that remote learners follow a regular school day and schedule while at home.

Limit Interruptions

Consider break times such as lunch, recess, or class change times to address the following with your child:

- Clothing
- Hygiene needs
- Snacks/Lunch
- Giving a to-do list that is not school related

*If you have a question for the teacher(s), they can be reached **after school** using the following methods:*

- Email
- Phone
- External services such as Class Dojo or Remind (If the teacher uses these services)
