



The Martin County School District will continue to provide transportation to students who rode the bus last year if they are returning to the same home zoned school for the 2018-2019 school year.

State legislation ([Rule 6A-3.001, Florida State Board of Education](#)) does not require school districts to provide transportation to students who live within a 2-mile radius of their zoned school unless specific circumstances exist. In recent years, the District has provided courtesy transportation to many students who live within a 2-mile radius of their school.

Courtesy transportation will **only** be provided to students residing less than 2 miles from their zoned school if they rode the bus last school year and are returning to the same school this year.

Students who live more than 2 miles from their assigned school will continue to be eligible for transportation in accordance with state regulations.
