Safety provisions you can expect for campus learners:

- First and foremost, we are asking parents to keep students home when they are not feeling well. Once on campus, our staff will conduct wellness screening to identify students that are displaying symptoms of not feeling well. - All students will enter through the front doors. Students dropped off in the carline will
 walk to the front of the school to enter the school building. Staff will provide hand
 sanitizer and reminders for the students to wear their masks.
- Masks are required for all students and staff while on campus. The only exception is while students are playing outside or having an outside snack and eating lunch in the cafeteria.



- NO visitors are permitted on campus. If you receive a call from our clinic to pick up a sick child, you will show your identification through the glass at the front of the school. Your child will be escorted to the front office and released to you.
- To ensure social-distancing in the cafeteria. Please talk to your child's teacher about lunchtimes; snacks are highly recommended because of the lunches to practice social-distance.
