



Dress Code at JBE!

In order to ensure a safe and focused learning environment, we ask parents and students to dress their best. Below are highlights from the MCSD dress code policy. The full version of the Student Code of Conduct can be access at www.martinschools.org under Departments/Student Services.

Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times: Shoes must be closed toe. Sneakers are to worn every day. Boots and sandals are not permitted due to safety on the playground and physical education classes. We are a "Let's Move School" and encourage 60 minutes of physical activity a day which requires athletic shoe attire for safety.

- Strapless/backless tops and dresses are not allowed, along with outfits that expose the torso including, but not limited to; tank tops, spaghetti straps, halters, skin-tight clothing, or bathing suits (except with permission for specified events).
- Skirts, skorts, and dresses may not be shorter than 2 inches above the knee cap, and shorts may not be shorter than 4 inches above the knee. Skin-tight biker shorts, yoga pants, or leggings are prohibited.
- At the discretion of the administration, **JBE students will be required to wear collared shirts or collared dresses.** Jensen Beach Elementary spirit shirts will be permissible on Fridays and are available for purchase from the JBE PTA.
