Additionally, here's a list of supplies families might provide to best support your student:

- ✓ Backpack big enough to hold laptop and supplies
- ✓ Headphones
- ✓ Laptop case
- ✓ Wired mouse (if your child prefers)
- ✓ Dry erase markers (to avoid shared materials)
- ✓ Extra crayons and glue sticks for kindergarten students
- ✓ Reusable water bottle that closes tightly (so laptop won't get wet) clearly labeled with student name
- ✓ Alcohol based hand sanitizer
- ✓ Tissues
- ✓ Wet wipes (for student use)
- ✓ **Plastic travel soap container** clearly marked with student name to store mask when not being worn
- ✓ Extra disposable masks
- ✓ Lysol/Clorox wipes (for adult use)

As always, individual teachers may share classroom wish lists or items needed specifically for their class.

Arrangements will be made for families choosing the distance learning option to pick up student supplies before the start of school. More details coming soon.

Please note ALL K-5 students will need a school district issued device and will need to transport it between home and school each day. If your student does not already have a school laptop, there are plans for laptop distribution August 5th-7th. The district will share a detailed schedule soon.
