

Seawind Elementary Dress Code

Dear SeaWind Families,

Below please find our SWE Dress Code. Having a clearly defined dress code ensures that student learning time is free of distractions. Research shows that dressing for success leads to increased student achievement. Our dress code will be **strictly enforced**. We will have a “**Dressed for Success Check**” each morning. Please review the SWE Dress Code carefully as you make plans for the exciting school year ahead.

Shirts:

- Dresses and shirts with collars and sleeves are required. SWE spirit shirts may be worn on Fridays, Early Release Days, and field trips.
- A t-shirt may NOT be worn over a shirt with a collar.
- All shirts must be longer than the top of pants/skirts/skorts/shorts.
- Clothing with inappropriate/offensive language, message(s) or picture(s) is not permitted on campus.
- Collared shirts must be worn under all outerwear.
- Collared over-shirts or blouses must be buttoned.

Skirts/Skorts/Shorts/Pants:

- Skirts, skorts, dresses must be no shorter than 2” above the knee.
- Shorts must be no shorter than 4” above the knee and must be worn no lower than the hip.
- If choosing to wear leggings, skirts, skorts or dresses MUST be worn over leggings or tights and must meet the length requirements described above.
- Leggings may not be worn alone.
- Clothing, to include jeans, must not be torn or ripped.
- Words printed across the backside of pants, skirts, skorts are not permitted.
- Sweat pants and pajama pants may not be worn to school.

Shoes:

- Shoes must have a rubberlike sole that provides ample traction for PE days.
- Shoes must have a closed toe and closed heel to ensure student safety.
- Shoes with laces must be laced to the top and tied tightly.
- Examples of shoes NOT permitted include but not limited to: sandals, flip flops, cleats, high heels, shoes with wheels, clogs, and CROCS (with or without straps).

Accessories:

- Jewelry or long scarves that are at risk of getting pulled is considered a safety risk and will not be permitted.
- Any jewelry or trinkets that distracts/disrupts the learning environment is not permitted.
- No hats/head covering (to include jacket / sweatshirt hoods) or sunglasses may be worn inside the building without a doctor's note.
- Unnatural hair colors or glitter, hair streamers, extensions, distracting hair accessories and/or unusual haircuts are not permitted.
- Make-up and temporary tattoos are not permitted.
