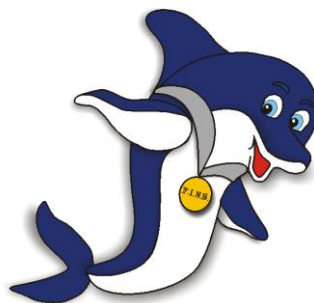
What Can Parents Do To Help?
