High school and college students around the country are organizing class walkouts on Election Day, which is tomorrow, November 6. While we encourage civic pride and respect students' desire to exercise their right to vote, the Martin County School District is not endorsing or sanctioning any type of walkout activity on our campuses. Again, Jensen Beach High School, Martin County High School and South Fork High School are not hosting, sponsoring or endorsing any type of walkout activity on November 6.

Students who elect to leave school campuses tomorrow will do so at their own risk – staff will not be responsible for or able to guarantee the safety of students who choose to exit school property. For these reasons, we ask parents and guardians to provide their child's school with the correct and necessary documentation if their child will need to leave campus early for any reason tomorrow. Students who elect to leave campus tomorrow without the appropriate documentation from their parent/guardian, and/or without completing the sign-out process through the main office at their school, may face disciplinary consequences.
