

If your GPA is not in one of the ranges of colleges/universities you may be interested in, check out the “succeed in college” option to determine alternate paths to meet your career goals.

You may be in that lower 25% of students accepted. So, still apply to a couple of those dream/somewhat realistic options. However, be sure to have a backup plan!
