Thank you for your interest in the TGR Learning Lab Summer Camp! This application includes information about our Summer Program and the application process.

Description of Summer Program: The TGR Learning Lab is offering a Summer Camp for students who are interested in a hands-on, interactive, career-focused experience. Classes are open to students who are currently in the 6th-8th grades.

Timeframe: Classes are held Monday – Thursday from 8:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. There are three different weeks to choose from; you may register for one class per week.

Fees: \$25 per week session. Once accepted, students will submit payment to their front office or Murray Middle School by May 3, 2019. Receipts will be given after payment is received.

SUMMER CAMP SESSIONS & CLASS OFFERINGS

The TGR Learning Lab Summer Camp provides a teacher-guided, hands-on career exploration experience around a STEM career that requires high school graduation and higher education. Session choices are as follows:

Comparative Zoology

Session 1: June 3 – 6

Dive into the Animal Kingdom and explore the psychology and physiology of bugs, reptiles, amphibians and mammals at a molecular and anatomical level. In this intensive biology class, you will investigate the digestive, cardiovascular, circulatory and excretory systems of animals while identifying the physiological differences of each species. Alternative Energy

Session 2: June 10 – 13

The Power of Chemistry

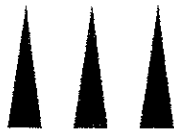
Session 3: June 17 – 20
