

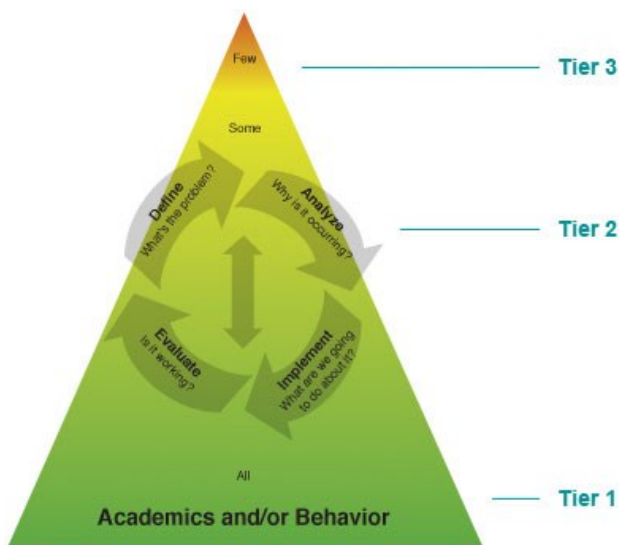

What is a Multi-Tiered System of Support?

MTSS is a term used to describe an evidence-based model of schooling, that uses data-based problem-solving, to integrate academic and behavioral instruction and intervention. The integrated instruction and intervention is provided to students at varying levels of intensity and time, based on student need. The goal is to prevent problems, academically and behaviorally, and to intervene early so that all students can be successful.

HOW CAN I PARTICIPATE IN MTSS?

Families play a critical role in supporting what their children are learning in school. The more parents are involved in student learning, the higher the student achievement. If your student is struggling with academics and/or behavior, contact the school's guidance department.

UNIVERSAL SUPPORT (TIER 1)

Core Instruction and Supports:

General academic and behavior instruction and support designed and differentiated for all students in all settings.

SUPPLEMENTAL SUPPORT (TIER 2)

Targeted Supplemental Interventions and Supports:

More focused, targeted instruction/intervention and supplemental support in addition to and aligned with the core academic and behavior curriculum and instruction.

INTENSIVE SUPPORT (TIER 3)

Intensive Individualized Interventions and Supports:

More focused, targeted instruction/intervention and supplemental support in addition to and aligned with the core academic and behavior curriculum and instruction.
