### ELIGIBILITY

Any enrolled student is eligible for coverage.

### COVERAGE OPTIONS

#### • SCHOOL TIME ACCIDENT COVERAGE

Travel coverage is provided to or after school activities, as a member of a group, in transportation furnished or arranged by the policyholder, as well as travel directly to or from their home premises and the school or the site of a covered activity. No coverage is provided while participating in interscholastic sports.

#### • 24-HOUR ACCIDENT COVERAGE

Provides coverage on and off school premises around the clock. Applies during weekends, summer and vacation periods. No coverage is provided while participating in interscholastic sports.

#### • 24-HOUR DENTAL COVERAGE

Covers dental injuries due to accidents.

### PAYMENT

Parents or guardians of students are responsible for enrollment and premium payment.

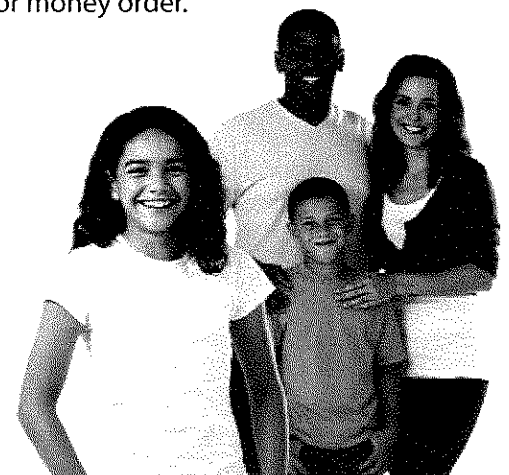
