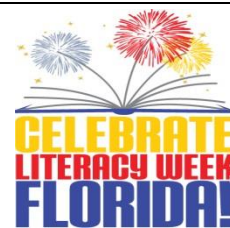

<p><b>Monday, Jan. 27</b></p> <p><i>School-wide Media Center Morning News</i></p>	<p><b>Celebrate Literacy week kickoff</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Kickoff of Celebrate Literacy Week</b> will begin with the morning news. Media Specialist will share all the exciting activities that will be taking place throughout the week.</li> </ul> <p><b>All American Reader</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will take the literacy pledge.</li> <li>• Students and staff wear red, white and blue.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Tuesday, Jan. 28</b></p> <p><i>Classrooms</i></p>	<p><b>Send Me a Setting Postcard</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will discover that books are an adventure and that through books we can travel anywhere in the world (or even out of this world!)</li> <li>• Students will pick a setting of their choice from a favorite book (any genre) and create a postcard including a description of the setting as well as details of the adventures they experienced while they were visiting the location of choice.</li> <li>• Teachers are encouraged to display the postcards outside of their classroom.</li> </ul>

Write about what makes Citrus Grove so special.</li> <li>• Students and staff alike are encouraged to take to the Grove Lawn to read, write, listen and speak.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Thursday, Jan. 30</b></p> <p><i>Classrooms</i></p>	<p><b>Reading Knocks Your Socks off</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students wear fun socks</li> <li>• Special time given in classrooms to sit back, prop up your feet and get lost in a good book</li> </ul>
