Recently, there have been numerous incidents of visiting parents/guardians/guests not adhering to campus rules during lunch time at schools (including CGE).

For security purposes, the following strategy will be fully implemented beginning January 7, 2019:

Parent(s)/Guardian(s) listed on the “yellow card” wishing to have lunch with their child will check their child out from the administration office and may enjoy having lunch with their child at the CGE Al Fresco dining area located in front of the school. The parent/guardian will then check their child back into the school no later than the end of their child’s scheduled lunch period to ensure their child rejoins their class before instruction resumes.

Please be sure that you send a note with your child stating your intentions to have your child join you for lunch and whether or not your child will need to be provided a school lunch before joining you.

With incidents occurring daily at campuses across the USA, this is a necessary and vital step in keeping our students, staff, parents/guardians and visitors safe.

We are in the process of relocating picnic tables to the CGE Al Fresco dining area. Umbrellas have been purchased for the tables, and new garbage cans are also on the way. We will also be beautifying the area with potted plants. CGE is also looking into the possibility of building a shade canopy for the area in the near future.
